



Call for: ***MIRTHE Research & Teaching Fellows***

- **MIRTHE is inviting applications for its Research & Teaching Fellows program.**
- The successful candidate will conduct original research in a field related to MIRTHE under the guidance of a MIRTHE faculty member. Collaborative, interdisciplinary research projects are preferred.
- The candidate will collaborate with MIRTHE faculty on a MIRTHE-wide educational project, such as MIRTHE-related course-development, short-course development, etc..
- The initial appointment is for 1 year, extendable to 3 years, with 2/3 of the compensation paid through MIRTHE core funds, and 1/3 remaining the responsibility of the sponsoring faculty (who may use their own MIRTHE funds). The appointment can be through any of the MIRTHE partner universities. Salary and rank will be commensurate with experience. Women and minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
- The ideal candidate should have a Ph.D. and experience in a field related to MIRTHE, and an interest in all fields covered by MIRTHE. The ideal candidate should also have a sincere interest in an academic career and in teaching.
- Interested applicants should send a preliminary application consisting of a resume, a brief statement of research, teaching and career interests, and a supporting letter of the sponsoring faculty to Ms. Roxanne Zellin, rzellin@princeton.edu. Applications are considered any time; 1 – 2 appointments are expected for the 2009/2010 MIRTHE award year. Decisions on awarding this post-doctoral fellowship will be made by MIRTHE's directors and thrust leaders.
